for the session was Ms. Reshma Chandramohan, Proprietor of Prakruti, who shared valuable insights into the philosophy and practice of permaculture.



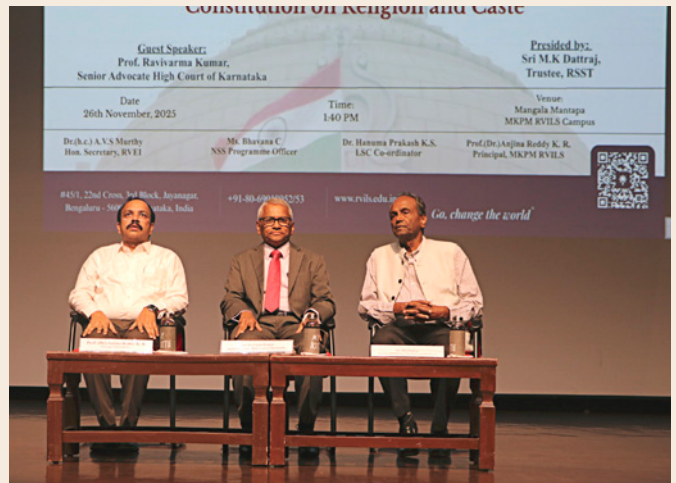
